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# BROADCLOTH CHRISTMAS RAG WREATH

**e** EASY

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Scissors
- Tape measure,
- Quilting Ruler
- Cutting Mat
- Rotary Cutter
- 0.4m of Broadcloth fabric in 4 colours (or as many colours as you like)
- Offray 2.7m rolls of Ribbons in 4 designs (or as many designs as you like)
- Metal Wire Wreath 35cm

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 1** - Cut each Broadcloth fabric into 2.5cm (1") wide by 20cm (8") long strips. Cut ribbons into 20cm lengths.

**Step 2** - Sort the strips & ribbons into piles of each colour/design, and lay them in the order that you would like them tied onto the wreath.

**Step 3** - Starting on the inner rail, tie the first strip tightly around the rail with tight knot. Push to one side with the ends facing upwards.

**Step 4** - Continue to tie the strips/ribbons onto the rail in the same manner in your desired order. Tie as many or little strips/ribbons as you like to the rail to achieve desired fullness.

**Step 5** - Once happy with the fullness of inner rail, repeat tying strips/ribbons to outer rail until desired fullness is achieved.

**TIP** - Strips can also be cut with pinking shears, rotary cutter with a decorative blade or simply torn for different looks.
