### CHRISTMAS BRIGHTS TABLE RUNNER

## BEGINNER

#### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

#### Size 1.2m x 40cm


- Sew Easy 60 degrees Triangle Ruler
- 4 x 25 cm of Christmas fabrics
- 1 x 1 meter Christmas fabrics for border, backing and tree
- 1 x 50 cm Christmas fabrics for binding and tree
- 1 fat quarter for the trunk
- 75 cm white tone on tone for Background
- 1.3 meter Pellon
- Gutermann Thread
- Sewing Machine
- Pins
- Safety pins for basting
- Clips for binding
- Sewing Machine
- Rotary Cutter
- Quilting Ruler
- Iron

#### CUTTING:

- For the trees, cut 1 x 2" strips from each fabric
- For the trunk, cut four pieces of 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  from the fat quarter
- From white tone on tone cut eight pieces of 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 5  $\frac{1}{2}$
- Cut a 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" strip of white fabric. Then, using the ruler, cut four large triangles from the strip. Finally, cut large triangles in half to create 8 thinner triangles.
- $\bullet$  Cut 8 pieces of 1  $\ensuremath{\sc {2}}\xspace$  " from the white tone on tone
- Cut 3 strips of 2 ½" for border


#### INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 1** - Arrange the strips of fabrics for the tree in a pleasing order and stitch them all together.



**Step 2 -** After sewing together cut out 4 trees using the 60-degree ruler.

**Step 3 -** Sew the half-triangles onto either side of the 60-degree triangle.




**Step 4 -** Sew the 1 ¼" strips either side of the tree.

**Step 5 -** Sew the background 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " either side of the trunk.

**Step 6 -** Sew the tree and the trunk together to form the block.

**Step 7 -** Sew the trees together with two on either side facing towards the center.





**Step 8 -** Sew the borders on the long sides of the runner.

**Step 9 -** Sew the border ends on the runner.

**Step 10 -** Press the top onto the Pellon and then lay on the backing and pin baste.

**Step 11 -** Quilt as desired using a walking foot or free motion.

**Step 12 -** Trim ready to bind.

**Step 13 -** Bind table runner using the binding strips. Sew to the back of the runner first then bring to the front and stitch down with a decorative stitch.
