

# CHRISTMAS CARD MAKING **PROJECT**



# INTERMEDIATE

# **OPTION 1**

#### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Christmas paper pad
- · Christmas die-cuts
- White cardstock
- Foam squares
- Adhesive.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Step 1 - Cut a sheet of Christmas paper 10x14cm. Attach to front of A6 sized white card.

Step 2 - Cut white piece of cardstock 4cm x 14cm and a piece of Christmas paper 3.5cm x 13cm. Attach Christmas paper to the centre of the white cardstock. Adhere offcentre left to the Christmas paper attached in Step 1.

Step 3 - Laver die-cuts in the middle of the card. Pop some up with foam tape to give a 3D effect. Attach a Christmas sentiment underneath the die-cuts.

# **OPTION 2**

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Christmas paper pad
- Christmas die-cuts
- Silver cardstock
- Foam squares
- Adhesive.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Step 1 - Punch or cut a 7.5cm circle.

Step 2 - Laver three Christmas tree die-cuts onto the circle. Decorate the trees with bling stickers. Attach circle to middle of card using foam squares.

Step 3 - Attach a sentiment from the diecut pack to some silver cardstock. Cut this out and attach to the front of the card underneath the circle using foam squares.
