WHAT YOU'LL NEED


- 1.6 metres of white fabric
- 40cm of a selection of 9 patterned fabrics
- Allow another 40cm for binding
- Backing Fabric will need to be 170 x 170cm

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1 - From the white fabric cut 49 7 x 7 inch squares and cross cut them in half forming 98 triangles.

Step 2 - Cut a total of 49 7x7 inch squares from your selection of patterned fabrics and cross cut them in half creating another 98 triangles.

Step 3 – With 1 patterned fabric and 1 white piece of fabric, lay them over one another right sides facing and using your quarter inch foot sew a seam down the side.



Step 4 – Work in pairs for the remainder of the matching up of the triangles. You need 4 triangles altogether to make your block.

Step 5 – Once all of your 49 blocks are completed, begin sewing them together to form larger blocks. Eventually making 7 rows across and 7 rows down.

Step 6 - Sandwich and quilt.
