# PEACOCK ALLEY QUILT

**e** EASY

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 1 Peacock Panel
- 110cm - Border Fabric
- A variety of 6 fabrics 20cm each
- 2m of wadding

## FINISHED SIZE

135cm x 165cm (Approximately)

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 1** - Cut your Peacock panel to size. This should be approximately 24 x 43 inches.

**Step 2** - From each of your 6 fabrics, cut 2.3 inch strips.

**Step 3** - Sew 2 sets of 6 strips each together. Gently press in between each strip sewn.



**Step 4** - Cut in strips of 7.5 inches wide - you will need 12 of these altogether



**Step 5** - Sew sets of 3 strips together.



**Step 6** - Attach a full set of 3 strips down the length of the panel on either side.

**Step 7** - The remaining strips on the top and the bottom have a spare 2 strips to allow for if there is any overlay with the cut of your panel.



**Step 8** - From your border fabric join strips of 7 inch width to the outside of the quilt top.

**Step 9** - Sandwich and Quilt.
