

PEACOCK ALLEY QUILT



e EASY

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 1 Peacock Panel
- 110cm Border Fabric
- A variety of 6 fabrics 20cm each
- 2m of wadding

FINISHED SIZE


135cm x 165cm (Approximately)

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1 - Cut your Peacock panel to size. This should be approximately 24 x 43 inches.

Step 2 - From each of your 6 fabrics, cut 2.3 inch strips.

Step 3 - Sew 2 sets of 6 strips each together. Gently press in between each strip sewn.



Step 4 - Cut in strips of 7.5 inches wide you will need 12 of these altogether



Step 5 - Sew sets of 3 strips together.



Step 6 - Attach a full set of 3 strips down the length of the panel on either side.

Step 7 - The remaining strips on the top and the bottom have a spare 2 strips to allow for if there is any overlay with the cut of your panel.



Step 8 - From your border fabric join strips of 7 inch width to the outside of the guilt top.

Step 9 - Sandwich and Quilt.
